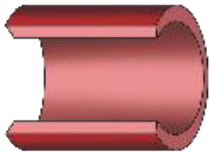

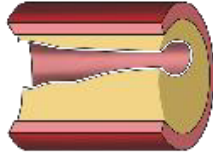

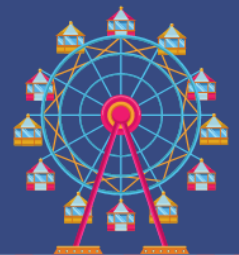

## **Graduate Gossip**

Completion of my Retailing and Tourism Management Degree included a writing project that studied local support for community small businesses. Based on findings from the literature review conducted and responses from community member surveys, many findings were validated. Individuals are motivated to participate in local community events when they feel a connection to their hometown. With a significant number of participants from survey responses indicating they are more likely to support a local business if they know the owners/employees or are familiar with the business through experience or exposure, it is more likely that community members will attend local community events when they feel the connection to aspects of the event. Results also suggested that individuals will spend their dollars at locally owned businesses when they desire to see these businesses stay in their small-town.

Customer experience has also shown to effect where individuals spend their dollars. If a local small entrepreneur provides quality products and services and creates a good experience for their customers, the data results suggest those customers are more likely to return as repeat customers. Previous research indicates that individuals involved with the planning process of an event will be more likely to participate in the event. Consistent with the survey results that support an increase of connectedness creates an increase of small-town participation, it is recommended to include as many people as possible throughout a strategic plan to develop a magnitude of by-in and support for the development of community events.
