





1) Mocha March

Route: Begin at Cynthiana Presbyterian Church. Walk north on Main Street to Pearl Street (old Cynthiana Cemetery). East on Pearl to Walnut. South on Walnut to Bridge Street. East on Bridge to Church Street(Leonos). North from Church to Reynolds Avenue. East on Reynolds to Oddville Avenue. West on Oddville to Church Street. South on Church to Pleasant Street. West from Pleasant to Main Street. North on Main Street back to parking lot. (\sim 2 miles)

Restaurant: Main Cup
