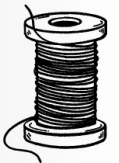

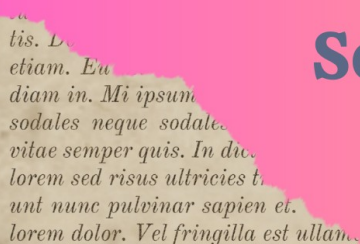

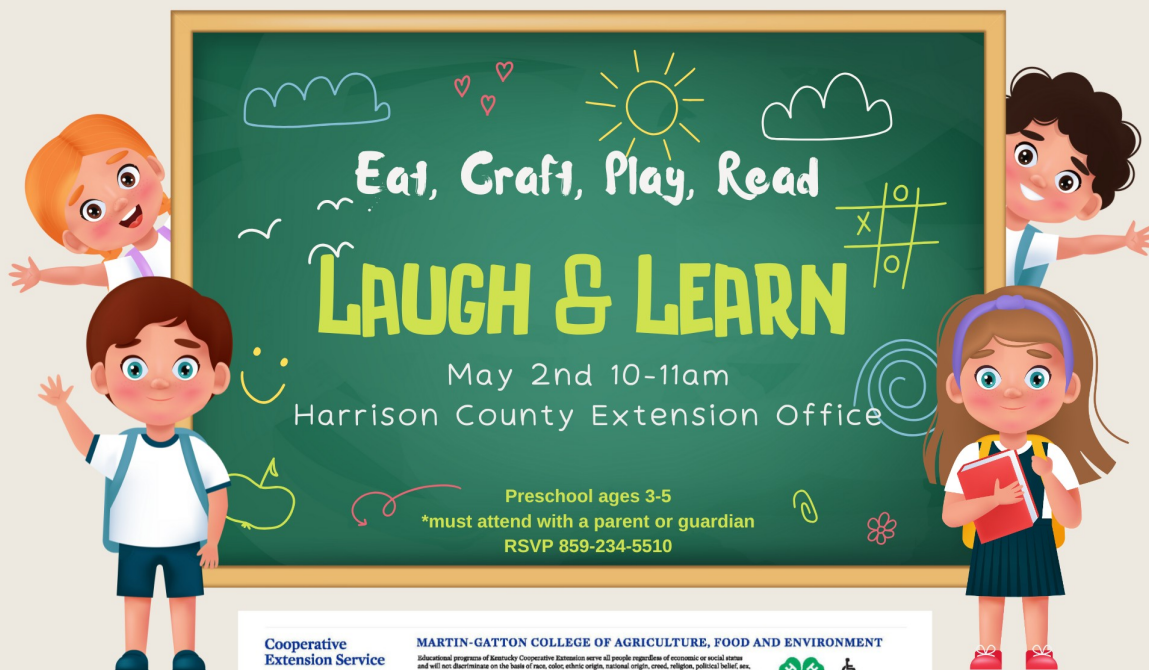

East on Bridge to Church Street (Leonos). North from Church to Reynolds Avenue. East on Reynolds to Oddville Avenue. West on Oddville to Church Street. South on Church to Pleasant Street. 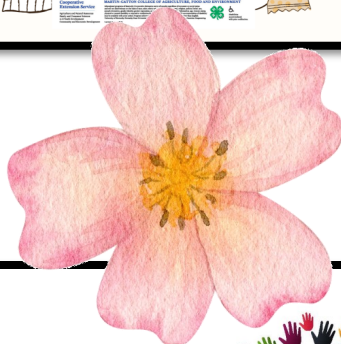
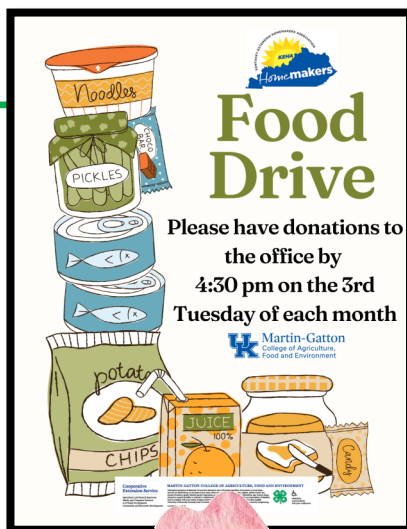
