



# Featured business of the month: The Flannel Store

This Downtown Edition features businesses from the Shop Cynthiana discount card.

The heart of The Flannel Store is the Bible verse attached to each pajama handmade onsite by Jelena Allen. From this central point, the story of The Flannel Store unfolds. This boutique is unique in that all flannel pajamas, loungewear, and blankets are sewn here on Pike Street in The Flannel Store sewing studio. From pattern design, fabric selection, cutting and sewing the garments, and hand stitching the Bible verse tags, everything is done in Cynthiana, Kentucky. Walking into the boutique, you'll hear "Hi there!" but might not see Jelena because she's sitting at a sewing machine.

In the early 2000's Jelena was in the phase of life raising her two little ones and working as a Certified Public Accountant building her tax and accounting firm. Loving cold weather and snowboarding, she often dreamed to have a boutique in a small mountain community selling men's and women's winter and spring wear, living a quiet life away from chaotic deadlines.

With the work stresses brought on by Covid, being an essential business, increased pandemic tax filing complexities, never-ending deadlines, and virtually no time off, she and husband lain felt it was the right time to make significant life changes and follow their dreams. Slow life down. Jelena had picked up sewing at the beginning of Covid as a means of destressing and often joked about doing it full time. Well...they moved cross country to Cynthiana, Kentucky a year later and The Flannel Store on E. Pike Street was born.

Knowing firsthand how stress and lack of sleep is terrible for the body, Jelena believes rest is vital. Not just sleep, but true rest. At The Flannel Store you will find high quality 100% GOTS-certified organic flannel pajamas for men and women. She is currently designing men's and women's robes, along with women's nightshirts and nightgowns. All with a modern but classic twist. Flannel blankets will be available this Christmas as well. 
